1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners intend to approach the respondent-State raising their grievance qua the transfer policy as to how they are prejudiced by the said policy hence, the respondents be directed to look into the said grievance and pass appropriate orders qua the grievance raised so that transfers are done in a systematic manner and the employees of the Transport Department does not feel harassed and rather their services are regulated in a smooth manner.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received from the petitioners raising any grievance and showing prejudice against the provisions of the transfer policy, the same will be looked into and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation and in case any of the grievance is liable to be redressed, the same will also be done by appropriate amendment to the policy concerned.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representation.
