Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of Mandamus is to decide the application under Section 14 of the Securitization and Re-construction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

2. The claim is that matter is pending since 16.01.2023 and as per the Section 13(4) notice dated 30.07.2021 (Annexure P-4) the outstandings are Rs.4,12,97,954.64 and thus recovery of public money is held up.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr.Shandilya accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

5. Keeping in view the above and in view of the settled principle of law and the limited prayer, we do not issue notice to respondent No.2. The present writ petition is disposed off, directing respondent No.1 to decide the application pending before him within a period of 4 weeks from today, in accordance with law, keeping in view the principles laid down in **Allahabad Bank, Branch at Industrial Area Vs. District Magistrate, Ludhiana & others, 2021 (4) RCR (Civil) 571.**
