Seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to investigate and take legal action in FIR No.0080 dated 04.06.2022 under Sections 420/120B IPC at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala, registered against respondents No.4 to 6 and file report under Section 173(2), the petitioner has come up before this Court.

2. I have gone through the file carefully.

3. The nature of the order, this Court proposes to pass, no notices are required to issue to the private respondents. Since the aggrieved person (being a widow lady) lost her property allegedly because of the forged signatures, as such the prayer of the present petition is allowed.
