Mr. Prabhjot S.Waraich, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the respondents and has filed his power of attorney. He accepts notice.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would not be pressing the present revision petition on merits. He submits that the Will in question is of the year 2012 and respondent No.1 was a signatory to the said Will. He submits that probably on account of some change in circumstances, respondent No.1 has convinced respondent No.2 to file the suit in question. He submits that the petitioners have no hesitation in contesting the suit but only

apprehends that efforts will be made by the present respondents-plaintiffs to delay the proceedings which they are already doing. He submits that the decision of the suit may be made time bound.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that he would have no objection if a reasonable time is granted for the decision of the suit.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the present revision petition has not been pressed on merits and further considering the fact that parties are closely related, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to decide the suit in question within a period of one year from today.

It goes without saying that both the parties will duly cooperate in the early decision of the suit and any attempt to delay the same would invite appropriate action as envisaged under the law against the party attempting to delay the disposal of the suit.
