The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the petitioners, who are juveniles, from jail forthwith as their further detention in the jail is violative of Articles 14, 20 and 21 of the Constitution of India and contrary to the provisions of the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2000.

It is averred in the petition that the petitioners, who were allegedly juveniles at the relevant point of time, had been ordered to be sent to Borstal Jail, Ludhiana for a period of five years commencing from 18.03.2005 to 17.03.2010.

Apparently, the period of above mentioned sentence has already expired. It appears that the petitioners might have undergone the entire sentence. Nonetheless, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners today.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
