SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondent No. 2, to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner and his family members, at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 8.

Learned State counsel submits that already a reply dated 28.10.2021 stands filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and as per para 1 of the preliminary submission, it is clear that present petition is nothing but a misconceived one.

Para 1 of the preliminary submission of said reply says as under:

“1. That on the same allegations, the wife of the petitioner namely Paramjit Kaur had also moved a representation dated 06.07.2021 bearing UID No.2095271 Annexure P-1 with the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana. Similarly the present petitioner had also moved a

representation dated 09.06.2021 bearing UID No.2116508 with the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana. In the said representations, it was alleged that on 03.07.2021 at about 02.00 PM, the private respondents came to the house of the petitioner and threatened the petitioner's wife and have planned to kill the petitioner. Enquiry on the said representations was conducted by the Incharge, P.P. Mundian Kalan (P.S. Jamalpur) Ludhiana during which it was revealed that earlier on the same allegations, the present petitioner had also filed a complaint bearing no.11/5D dated 09.07.2020 on which enquiry was conducted by the then SHO and he also visited the spot and ultimately it was revealed that false allegations have been levelled by the petitioner. During the enquiry, it was revealed that on the statement of respondent no.8, FIR No.94 dated 13.06.2020, u/s 341, 323, 506, 427, 188, 34 IPC, P.S. Jamalpur, Ludhiana has been registered against the present petitioner and his brother Dharamjit Singh in which the petitioner and his brother are facing the trial. Therefore the petitioner has filed the said applications in order to effect the investigation of that FIR registered against the petitioner and his brother. Apart from the above complaints, various other complaints were also moved by the petitioner with the Chairman, SC/ST Commission, Punjab, Chandigarh on which enquiry was got conducted from the SHO and the allegations of the petitioner were found to be false. However, there is absolutely no danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner from the private

respondents and all these allegations have been levelled with some ill motive. Hence, the present petition is liable to be dismissed on this ground alone.”

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
