On 16.05.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the order dated 21.02.2023 (Annexure P-3) vide which the bail of the petitioner stands cancelled and the bail bonds alongwith surety bonds were forfeited to the State due to his non-appearance on one date in case FIR No.534 dated 08.07.2017 under Sections 323, 307 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Sector 10, Gurugram.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of noting down of a wrong date, the petitioner was unable to appear on 21.02.2023 leading to the passing of the impugned order (Annexure P-3). He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

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In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Association for Children with Type 1 Diabetes, SCO 24, Sector 23-C, Chandigarh, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court of the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, and has since been admitted to interim bail as is borne out from the order dated 20.05.2023. A copy of the said order is taken on record as Mark ‘A’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial but for a sufficient cause.
