The present writ petition had been filed for seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.8 to submit the FSL report to the concerned authority in a time bound manner.

There is a written request for an adjournment circulated on behalf of the counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has informed that respondent No.8 has been improperly impleaded in the present case. It was further pointed out by the counsel that the deceased was initially admitted to CHC Banga where-from he was referred to GMC, Amritsar. Hence, he was never admitted for any examination before the Government Civil Hospital, Amritsar. She, however, contends that the prayer of the petitioner was only to the extent of supply of FSL report and as a matter of fact above said prayer stands already answered since the FSL report (Annexure P-2) has already been filed along with the reply which had been duly handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner as well.

In view of the above, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed and there seems to be no surviving cause of action. The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition in case any grievance still subsists.
