VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to conduct a fair and impartial inquiry, with a further prayer for setting aside the notice dated 08.04.2019 and 16.04.2019 issued by respondent no.5 to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State and the intervener have stated that in the present case no order under Section 216 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 has been passed against the petitioners and only notices have been issued which have been challenged in the present petition and thus, the present petition is premature. It is further submitted that after an order under Section 216 of the Act is passed, the petitioners have the remedy to file an appeal under Section 216 (3) of the Act.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioners to rebut the said stand taken by the respondents. No one had appeared on behalf of the petitioners on 07.09.2022.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
