The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in cross-case DDR No.40 dated 14.11.2021(Annexure P-2) registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 and Section 326 IPC added later on vide DDR No.25 dated 04.01.2022 in FIR No.146 dated 14.11.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Nehian Wala, District Bathinda.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 15.05.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from Kewal Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 15.05.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
