This is petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0062, dated 18.04.2023, under Sections 406, 120-B of IPC (Section 411 of IPC added later on), registered at P.S. Sadar, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar (Annexure P-1).

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance to the order dated 15.05.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation on 06.06.2023.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Narinder Singh, intimates that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance to the order dated 15.05.2023 passed by this Court and is no

4            Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.05.2023 is, hereby, confirmed subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further, he will not tamper with the evidence nor influence the witnesses; shall cooperate with the investigation as and when so required.
