This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the speaking order (communicated vide letter dated 01.11.2022) (Annexure P-12) passed by respondent no.2 vide which respondent no.2 had rejected the representation of the petitioner for making necessary correction in the revenue record and for restoring the name of the petitioner pertaining to land bearing khasra no.57//4/2 (7-11), 5/2(7-11) totalling 15 K 2 M situated at Tehsil Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a perusal of the order dated 01.11.2022 would show that reference has been made in paragraph 3 to letter dated 08.10.2015 and 25.09.2015 of the Revenue, Rehabilitation and Disaster Management Department, Punjab Government

vide which the allotment of land on the basis of policy dated 26.09.2007 in favour Tarsem has been cancelled and said Tarsem would be the predecessor in interest of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to challenge the said letters and other relevant documents, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
