SANJIV BERRY, J.(ORAL)

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurjeet Singh, intimates the Court that the complainant Darshan Singh, son of Late Hajura Singh, has already moved the application before the In-charge, Anti Human Traffic Unit, Commissionerate of Police, Amritsar, that he does not want to further proceed with his application dated 28.03.2023. ASI Gurjeet Singh submits that since interim order has been passed in the present petition as such they could not file the application and the same will be filed within ten days.

2. Faced with this situation, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that if the aforesaid application filed by complainant Darshan Singh as stated by ASI Gurjeet Singh is being filed, then the petition becomes infructuous and the same be disposed of accordingly with liberty to the

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petitioner to agitate the issue again, if so, required in future.

3. Keeping in view the above statements, petition stands disposed of accordingly, with aforesaid liberty.
4. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
