This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been moved by the petitioner for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.233 dated 08.10.2018 under Sections 341, 379-B, 384 and 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Gurdit Singh submits that in compliance of order dated 19.07.2021 and subsequent orders passed by this Court, petitioner has already joined investigation and is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation. She further submits that case property (mobile phone and ATM Card) has already been destroyed and to this effect, offence under Section 201 IPC has been added in the instant FIR.

In view of above, order dated 19.07.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
