The petitioner has approached this Court with a prayer to issue a writ of *mandamus* to the respondents to offer physical possession of plot no.635, Sector-57, Gurugram to the petitioner and if the same is not possible, to allot an alternative plot to the petitioner in the same vicinity. The details with regard to the allotment and thereafter the deposit of the amount have been given in the writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that when the possession of the plot i.e.No.635, Sector-57, Gurugram which was allotted to the petitioner was not granted, he had approached the respondent(s) for giving him an alternative plot. Pressing for the said claim, the petitioner had not only been approaching the respondent(s) but had also been putting forth the representations. Copies of those representations have been placed at **Annexures P-15 to P-17** dated 11.07.2022, 07.02.2023 and 27.03.2023. A reference has also been made to a representation dated 08.04.2018 (**Annexure P-13**).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he, at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to consider and

to take a decision on the representations as submitted by the petitioner, within some specified time.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Bhardwaj, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Ms. Vasundhra Asija, Advocate for Mr. Pravindra S. Chauhan, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-HSVP.

In the light of the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, we dispose of the present writ petition by directing the Chief Administrator, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran (HSVP)-respondent No.2 and the Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurugram-respondent No.3 to consider the representations dated 08.04.2018 (**Annexure P-13**), 11.07.2022, 07.02.2023 and 27.03.2023 (**Annexures P-15 to P-17**), within a period of six weeks. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

The consequential benefit(s), if any, the petitioner may be entitled to, in pursuance to the said decision be also released/ granted to the petitioner within a further period of two weeks.
