HARKESH MANUJA, J.(ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of complaint No.8498 dated 27.11.2015 as well as summoning order dated 30.11.2015 (Annexure P-3).

On 17.03.2012, this Court passed the following order:

“The parties to the dispute are ad idem that a sum of Rs.10 lakhs, which was deposited by the petitioner on 28.02.2017 and 04.03.2017 before the Registry of this Court already stand released in favour of the respondent-complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the petitioner is ready to compensate the complainant/legal heirs to the extent of Rs.1.5 lakhs towards full and final settlement pertaining to discharge of liability of cheque No.205501 dated 20.10.2015 drawn on ICICI Bank and undertakes to bring a demand draft to the tune of Rs.1.5 lakhs in the name of Sanjeev Bansal (legal heirs of complainant) on the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 24.03.2023.”

In pursuance to the aforesaid order, petitioner has handed over a draft of Rs.1,50,000/- bearing No.445543 dated 22.03.2023 in the name of Mr. Sanjeev Bansal to the learned counsel representing the respondent.

In view of the aforesaid payment, learned counsel for the respondent submits that aforementioned complaint shall be withdrawn by the legal heirs of the complainant who have already received the amount besides compensation as well. In view thereof, learned counsel for the respondent submits that legal heirs of the complainant who have already moved an application seeking their impleadment before the trial Court shall withdraw the complaint as having received the entire amount due towards the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid statement, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition at this stage.

Disposed of as not pressed.
