On 11.05.2023, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the petitioner was not apprehended at the spot but was implicated on the basis of disclosure statement made by co-accused-Krishan Ghai who has already been granted bail by the trial Court vide order dated 02.05.2023 and the recovery of mobile has been done by the Investigating Agency.

Notice of motion for 22.08.2023.

In the meanwhile, petitioner will join investigation before the Investigating Officer as and when called. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail, till the next date of hearing, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

It is informed by learned State Counsel, on instructions from

ASI Balraj Singh, that in compliance of the order dated 11.05.2023,

petitioner has since joined the investigation and he is no longer required

for any investigation.

In view of the afore-said statement, order dated 11.05.2023 whereby interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner in the FIR in question, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer and make compliance of the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
