Separate replies have been filed on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5. Copies thereof have been supplied to the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel points out that in the instant writ petition the petitioner had prayed for grant of parole/interim bail so as to avail the medical treatment of his own choice.

In the written statement that has been filed on behalf of the respondents, parole for a period of 08 weeks has already been granted to the husband of the petitioner for availing the medical treatment. She thus contends that grievance of the petitioner stands redressed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, however, contends that issue with regard to providing medical treatment to numerous under-trials/prisoners would be required to be examined.

I am afraid that such scope would fall under the Public Interest Litigation and cannot be gone at this stage.

The grievance of the petitioner having already been redressed, the present petition is disposed as having been rendered infructuous.

The petitioner, if so advised, agitate the larger question by filing an appropriate petition before the appropriate Court/Forum.

Pending misc. applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
