Main Case

Learned State counsel has referred to a statement made by the mother and natural guardian of the present petitioners, namely Manju Rani, on 28.07.2023 before the Sub Divisional Magistrate (Civil), Kalka, whereby she has stated that she has taken the possession of the house and presently residing in the said house, however, a statement is made that electricity and water supply connected has been disconnected.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 4 submits that in fact the electricity and water supply is disconnected due to non-payment of bills, which is to be paid by the petitioners.

Since the order stands complied with as the possession has been handed over and the dispute regarding payment of electricity and water supply bills is relating to disputed question of facts, no case of any willful disobedience is made out.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioners are granted liberty to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law, if so advised.
