Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that in all these writ petitions, the petitioner(s) are claiming the benefit of allotment of a plot in pursuance to the Policy of the respondent which entitled them for issuance of a plot under the Relocation Policy of Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (for short 'GMADA') dated 08.02.2014.

Counsel for the petitioner(s) contends that despite the petitioner(s) fulfilling the requirement and having been found so after the survey and resurvey, till date no benefit has been conferred upon them. Petitioner(s) have even served legal notices dated 23.03.2021 in CWP No. 14557 of 2021, CWP No. 16533 of 2021, CWP No. 16595 of 2021 and legal notice dated 29.03.2021 in CWP No. 16544 of 2021, but the same till date have not been decided by the respondents.

Counsel for the petitioner(s) contends that the petitioner(s), at this stage, would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent no.4-the Estate Officer, Greater Mohali Area Development Authority, PUDA Bhawan, SAS Nagar Mohali, to consider the same and decide within some specified time.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G.Jauhar, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In the light of the above, we dispose of the writ petition without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon with a direction to the Estate Officer, Greater Mohali Area Development Authority, PUDA Bhawan, SAS Nagar Mohali/respondent No.4 to consider and decide the legal notices as have been served on 23.03.2021 and 29.03.2021 by the petitioner(s) within a period of eight

weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner(s) forthwith.

In case, they are found to be entitled to the relief as has been claimed, the consequential benefits be also granted to them within a period of six weeks.
