1. Prayer in the present Criminal Revision Petition was impugning the order dated 25.10.2021 whereby the application filed by the petitioner for grant of interim maintenance was declined primarily on the ground that the petitioner is a major and since she has herself taken a decision to live of her own, as such, the respondent is not legally bound to maintain the major daughter.
2. The only prayer has been made that the main petition is pending for recording of the evidence of the petitioner and in case the Family Court expedites the proceedings, the petitioner will get a chance to lead evidence and rely upon the documents which were not considered by the Family Court at the time of dismissal of the interim application.
3. In view of the above submission and keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner, issuance of notice to the respondents is dispensed with.
4. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of being not pressed at this stage.
5. The Family Court is requested to expedite the trial and decide the same preferably within a period of six months.
6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of
