HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.188 dated 28.04.2022, registered under Sections 406, 420, 469 IPC, at Police Station IMT Rohtak, District Rohtak.
2. Vide order dated 06.07.2023, the arrest of the petitioner was stayed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for respondent No.3, submit that the matter has been settled between the parties in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and compromise/settlement has also been executed, on 18.08.2023, which is also duly signed by the parties. As per the compromise/settlement, the amount of

Rs.9,79,000/- would be paid by the petitioner to respondent No.3 in 10 installments.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
5. Since the matter has already been settled between the parties on 18.08.2023 in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 06.07.2023 is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
