MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

1. This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0041 dated 10.02.2023 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and Section 120-B IPC 1860, registered at Police Station N.I.T., Faridabad.
2. After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned counsel, on instructions from petitioner, wishes to withdraw the petition at this stage with liberty to approach the learned trial Court for seeking bail pending trial. However, learned counsel submits that petitioner was granted interim bail vide order dated 30.05.2023 by the Co-ordinate Bench and the same is continuing till date, thus, he be granted two weeks time from today to surrender before learned trial Court.
3. Ordered accordingly.
4. Also observed that in case after surrender petitioner applies for regular bail before learned trial Court, the same be considered in accordance with law, without being influenced with the observations made hereinabove.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
