Main case:

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case bearing FIR No.58 dated 08.05.2021 under Sections 452/436/427/336/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 307 added and Section 452 of IPC deleted later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 02.06.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 02.06.2022, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 02.06.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
