VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 09.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed in ROR No.881 of 2022 passed by respondent No.1, whereby the revision petition filed by the petitioners has been dismissed and other orders have also been challenged.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of para 27 of the judgment passed by the Division Bench of this Court in the case titled as **Jagjit Singh Vs. Divisional Commissioner, Patiala and others** reported as **2012(13) RCR (Civil) 96**, and also in view of the fact that it has been mentioned in the order of the Financial Commissioner as well as

the Commissioner that the verdict of the Civil Court will be followed by the Revenue Authorities and the said Civil Suit has already been filed by respondent No.5 and the same is pending and also the fact that the Commissioner had, as a matter of abundant caution, directed that an entry be made in red ink in the jamabandi to the effect that the land in question is under litigation, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition with liberty to the petitioners to take up all the points which have been raised in the present writ petition and are available to them in the civil proceedings.

3. It is made clear that when the civil suit is finally decided, the mutation entries would be made in accordance with the judgment of the Civil Court.
