[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of compromise having been entered between the parties, besides the petitioner having undergone 02 years 02 months of detention post arrest and the trial not making head way, he may be permitted to withdraw the petition to file a fresh petition before the learned trial Court in accordance with law.

[2] Learned counsel for the complainant as well as learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, admit the factum of compromise having taken place between the parties and also state that they have no objection if the prayer as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted.

[3] In the circumstances and in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is permitted to be withdrawn with the liberty to invoke the jurisdiction of the learned trial Court in accordance with law.
