By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 17.08.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner had already joined the investigation in the case and as such prayed for concession of anticipatory bail.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ajay, P.S. Hisar Sadar, Hisar intimates that the petitioner had already joined the

investigation and is no more required for further investigation. Learned State counsel further submits that the petitioner is no more required for any custodial interrogation in this case.

4. Keeping in view of these facts, the interim bail granted vide order 17.08.2023 is hereby confirmed in the present FIR No.0204, dated 09.03.2023 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 341, 506 of IPC and Sections 325, 326 and 307 of IPC added later on (Annexure P-1), subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, that the petitioner will come and join the investigation as and when so required; will not tamper with the evidence and will not leave the country without prior permission and will appear in Court on each and every date of hearing.

5. The petition stands allowed.
