The petitioner has sought quashing of Inquiry Report dated 04.01.2016 (Annexure P-3) submitted by DSP, Sangrur in case bearing FIR No.54 dated 24.10.2015 under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station City Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar, has reiterated that during the pendency of the instant petition, the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, had on the last date of hearing sought an adjournment to verify the authenticity of the submissions made by the learned State counsel, with respect to the
