By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) and further prayer is to set aside the order dated 03.05.2023 (Annexure P-2). Details of the FIR are as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance with the order dated 12.05.2023 passed by this Court.
