The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No160 dated 31.08.2019 under Sections 307, 336, 326, 324, 323, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar and Section 226 (added later on) on 06.07.2021 vide DDR No.030.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 12.05.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 12.05.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 12.05.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
