VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to provide adequate security to them as they apprehend a threat to their lives from respondent Nos.4 to 7.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that they being majors have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondents are not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and are extending threats to them. The copies of 'Aadhaar' card (Annexures P-1 and P-2) of petitioner Nos.1 and 2 have been placed on record.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, A.A.G., Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
5. Without commenting upon the validity of the marriage, the present

representation dated 09.05.2023 (Annexure P-4) and take requisite action, if so warranted, as per the facts and circumstances of the matter in accordance with law.
