This petition is filed by the petitioner/husband for transfer of a petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, bearing No.HMA No.123 of 2020 titled as "*Kiran Bala vs Shekhar Panwar*", from the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Kurukshetra to the competent Court of jurisdiction at Panchkula.

Admittedly, the respondent/wife has got registered an FIR No.100 dated 28.04.2012 under Sections 323, 406, 498-A and 506 IPC at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra, where the petitioner/husband is appearing.

The respondent/wife has also filed a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which is also pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Kurukshetra.

Counsel for the petitioner could not make out any good ground as to why this petition be transferred to the competent Court of jurisdiction at Panchkula as two other litigations are already pending at Kurukshetra, filed at the instance of the respondent/wife.

Accordingly, no ground to transfer the petition from the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Kurukshetra to the competent Court of jurisdiction at Panchkula, is made out.
