The petitioner has approached this Court seeking writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to amend the date of birth of the petitioner in its records.

2. The apprehension of the petitioner stems out from the fact that the freshly issued identity card to the petitioner bears date of birth of the petitioner as 08.12.1965, whereas as per the petitioner the correct date of birth is 26.01.1967.

3. Though, it is trite law that this Court would not interfere in the writ jurisdiction for correction of date of birth. However, this Court finds that there seems to be more than one document on record that too borne out of the records maintained by the respondent, wherein earlier the date of birth of the petitioner was mentioned as 26.01.1967.

4. In view of the above, this Court finds that without commenting on the merits of the present case, it will be appropriate that the respondents decide undated representation made by the petitioner appended alongwith the writ petition as P-7.
5. Mr. Dhir submits that the same would be decided within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
6. Disposed off, accordingly.
