Report from the trial Court has been received, according to which, it has been informed that despite directions issued by this Court, parties have failed to appear before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar till 17.07.2023 as such their statements could not be recorded. Hence, it cannot not be said as to whether the compromise effected between the parties is genuine or not.

Status report has been filed by the State counsel in Court today. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to counsel opposite. It is stated in the said report that accused Lucky Kumar and present petitioner Jagriti @ Jagreeti were arrested and final report (challan) under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. has been filed in the present case and the investigating officer is having no knowledge about the compromise between the parties.

In such circumstances, there are no grounds to allow the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.83/2023 registered under Sections 354-A & 506 IPC and Sections 10 & 21 of POCSO Act, 2012 at Police Station Sadar Amritsar on the basis of alleged compromise. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
