HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 129 dated 21.04.2023 registered under Sections 306, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station Tripri, District Patiala.
2. Vide order dated 12.05.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 12.05.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that the petitioner has also surrendered his mobile phone.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.05.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
