Both the counsel appearing on behalf of the parties are ad idem that compromise has been effected between the parties during the mediation proceedings which were carried out in the mediation center of this Court and that the concerned settlement deed is dated 02.11.2021 (Annexure A-1) and that in compliance of said settlement deed, the entire settled amount has been paid by the petitioner to the respondent/complainant-Rajeev Jain son of Surinder Kumar Jain, proprietor M/s Jain Yarns, Ludhiana and that now nothing remains due against the petitioner.

The counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-Rajeev Jain has today given undertaking that as the matter stands compromised between the parties, the complainant will withdraw the criminal complaint in question (Annexure P-7) filed under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act, which is presently pending before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana.

The counsel for the petitioner in all the connected cases made prayer that in view of the aforesaid undertaking given by counsel for the respondent/complainant-Rajeev Jain, he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to revive the same, if in future any cause of action survives.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
