The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.37 dated 24.03.2023 registered under Sections 452, 324, 148, 149 IPC, Section 452 IPC deleted vide DDR No.66 dated 24.03.2023 Annexure P-2 and Section 326 IPC added vide DDR No.47 dated 19.04.2023 (Annexure P-7) at Police Station City-I, Mansa, District Mansa.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 15.05.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 17.07.2023 by way of an affidavit of Sanjeev Goyal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Mansa, District Mansa has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

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In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 15.05.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
