While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed
on 15.05.2023:-

“It is submitted that even if the allegations in
the FIR are taken to be correct, offence under
Section 306 IPC would not be made out.

Notice of motion for 02.08.2023.

Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, AAG Punjab accepts
notice on behalf of the respondent-State and waives
service.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join
investigation with the Investigating Officer on
25.05.2023 at 10.00 a.m. and co-operate therewith.
In the event of her arrest, she shall be released on
interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating
Officer/SHO concerned subject to her joining the
investigation and compliance of the provisions
enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

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2. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, has stated that pursuant to the order dated 15.05.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
3. In view of above, the interim order dated 15.05.2023 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
4. Petition stands disposed off.
