The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in the above-captioned case.

2. At this stage, Mr. Vishavjeet Singh Rishi, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record.

3. Upon notice and after hearing learned counsel for the State, the petitioner was directed to join investigation and was granted interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 17.05.2023.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljeet Singh, Police Station Tibba, submits that in pursuance to order dated 17.05.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 17.05.2023 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
