1. The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents No. 1 to 5 to take strict legal action against private respondents on the basis of representations (Annexures P-3 and P-4) duly served by the petitioner and further prayer has been made for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents.

2. Learned State counsel, at the outset, refers to para No. 7 of the reply filed in CRM-M-25795-2022, and submits that on 30.10.2022, the petitioner i.e. Mr. Parshotam Das, made a statement to the Police that he has two daughters and one son and all are married and now he has no danger of

any kind and he has no dispute with anyone.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no surviving grievance remains to be adjudicated in the present petition and he is satisfied and the petition be disposed of in terms of the statement suffered by Mr. Parshotam Das before the Police on 30.10.2022.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, seeks liberty to approach the concerned quarter in case any specific instance occurs in future endangering the petitioner’s life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

5. In view of the above both these petitions are hereby disposed of as such, with liberty as aforesaid.
