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**DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (Oral)**

On 17.05.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

*“Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.582 dated 10.8.2022 registered under Sections 379-B, 341, 365, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station City, District Rohtak.*

*The counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case as she is real sister of main accused Daya Kaur, who is already arrested by the police. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that no specific allegations are made against the petitioner in the entire FIR and that the petitioner who is unmarried girl and is having no criminal history is ready to join investigation with the police.*

*Notice of motion.*

*On the asking of the Court, Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG, accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana and on instructions from ASI Bhoop Singh submits that the petitioner is also named in the FIR along with her sister Daya Kaur, who is the main accused in the present case and has been arrested by the police. However, the State counsel has not disputed the fact that no specific allegations are appearing on the record against the petitioner, who is having no criminal history.*

*In view of the above, in case of arrest, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail by the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to his own satisfaction. The petitioner should join investigation with the police well in time before the next date of hearing and to abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.*

*The report of the Investigating Officer be also called in this context on the next date of hearing.*

*Now be listed on 30.10.2023.”*

Today, it is informed by learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Budh Singh, that in compliance of the order dated 17.05.2023, petitioner has since joined the investigation and she is no longer required for any investigation.

In view of the afore-said statement, order dated 17.05.2023 whereby interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner in the FIR in question, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer and make compliance of the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
