AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

This is the 2nd petition filed under Section 438 CrPC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case of FIR No.61 dated 24.03.2021 registered under Sections 420 and 406 IPC, at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lakhvir Singh submits that in pursuance to order dated 16.03.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has not joined investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pleads no instructions.

Vide order dated 20.09.2022, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and was directed to join investigation. Thereafter, vide order dated 13.12.2022, he sought one more opportunity, which was also granted to join investigation on 19.11.2022 at 11:00 AM, but he did not do so, as is reflected in the order dated 16.03.2023. However, he was again granted last opportunity to do

the needful vide the said order on or before 12.04.2022 and it was clarified that if he does not join investigation, the petition shall be deemed to be dismissed. Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that the petitioner did not still join investigation.

It appears that the petitioner has scant regard for the orders passed by this Court.

In view of the facts noticed above, the present petition stands dismissed.
