The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners who are allegedly being harassed by the private respondents by illegally trespassing into their house.

Reply by way of Jangjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib had been filed wherein it was averred that the grievance of the petitioners already stands redressed and a statement of the petitioner-Ranjit Singh has also been recorded by the respondents, in which it has been averred that he does not apprehend any further danger and if he would feel any danger to his life or liberty in future, he shall submit fresh application.

The statement of petitioner- Ranjit Singh is extract hereinafter below:

“Made the statement that I am a resident of the said address. I have filed a petition CRM-W No.1185 & CRWP-8269-2020 Ranjit Singh V/S State of Punjab and Others before the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court Chandigarh for the protection of myself and my wife Jasmail Kaur. In pursuant to the order dated 03.09.2022, HC Harpreet Singh No. 1013/FGS was attached with me for the protection of mine and my family. Since I did not apprehend any danger, after coming to Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, I said that at present I do not need any security, if in future I need security then I will take protection again if needed. HC Harpreet Singh No. 1013/FGS was attached with me has been sent back by me. Furthermore I have submitted an application to Hon'ble S.S.P. Sahib, Fatehgarh Sahib. I do not want that any action be taken on that application, if I have to take any action on that application, then I will again submit a separate application in the office of Hon'ble SSP Fatehgarh Sahib. At present, I do not want to take any protection on this petition, nor do I want to take any legal action on this petition. Got recorded statement.”

In view of the above statement of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
