In compliance of the order dated 18.05.2023, status report by way of affidavit of Shri Kulwant Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Tanda, District Hoshiarpur on behalf of respondent-State has been filed, as per which after re-investigation as per direction of learned Area Magistrate, cancellation report has been prepared on 21.06.2023, which shall be presented before learned Area Magistrate soon.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are aged 68 years and that investigation has been conducted time and again, but the matter is hanging on their head since long. The limited prayer at this stage made by learned counsel for the petitioners is to direct the Trial Court to dispose of the cancellation report as and when it is filed within a time bound manner. As the cancellation report is still to be filed after re-investigation of the police, obviously complainant will have to be served notice.

In the circumstances, it is directed that as and when the cancellation report is filed before the Trial Court, the same shall be disposed of by the Trial Court within two months positively from the date of filing of the cancellation report, as per law.
