The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.204 dated 05.07.2020 under Sections 420 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2-bank as well as learned counsel for respondent No.3-complainant have not controverted the submissions made by the counsel opposite that the entire amount has been duly paid and the matter stands settled between the parties. They also do not oppose the prayer made for grant of anticipatory bail. In support, copies of acknowledgement and affidavit given by the complainant are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the

petitioner be admitted to anticipatory bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court concerned. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
