Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the prosecutrix has made allegations against the petitioner on the basis of political enmity. It is submitted that in the broad daylight, it is highly improbable that the petitioner would have committed the act as alleged by the prosecutrix. He further submits that the petitioner is innocent.

I have considered the submissions.

Taking into consideration the allegations of the petitioner having teased the prosecutrix and that she is a labourer and her husband is a driver, it cannot be said that the allegations are based on any political enmity.

No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
