Challenge in the present criminal writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 (1) (d) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners Temporary Release Act, 1962 is for grant of parole for a period of 70 days and also on account of attending the marriage of nephews of the petitioner on 20.05.2023.

2. Counsel for the petitioner does not press the prayer for grant of regular parole, since on an earlier occasion also on 15.05.2023 she had restricted her prayer that the petitioner be released on parole to attend the marriage of the nephews under armed guard, which is slated for 20.05.2023.

3. The factum of the said marriage has been confirmed by the counsel for the State, which is to take place from 19.05.2023 to 21.05.2023.

4. Accordingly, the Superintendent, District Jail, Nuh shall ensure release of the petitioner for attending the marriage of the nephews on 20.05.2023 under Armed Guard, since the ceremony is stated to be in District Sonapat. The petitioner’s relatives shall make arrangement for transportation of the petitioner and the armed guard. The petitioner, thus, be released at 7:00 AM and he shall surrender back in jail at 5:00 PM.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
