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In response to the notice, Raman Dhingra-Appellant along with Mr. Rao Ajender Singh, Advocate has put in appearance. Mr. Rao Ajender Singh, Advocate has filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record.

As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellant, appellant appearing in person as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellant-Raman Dhingra S/o Sh. Jagan Nath, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a cheque in the sum of Rs.3,50,000/- favouring the appellant-Raman Dhingra S/o Sh. Jagan Nath, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of.
