1. Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of Mandamus is to implement the order dated 24.10.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed in the application under Section 14 of the Securitization and Re-construction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (for short 'the Act') by the Additional District Magistrate, Ludhiana. As per the Section 13 (2) notice dated 01.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) and notice under Section 13 (4) dated 21.08.2019 (Annexure P-2), the outstandings are ₹25,69,913.46/-.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Navneet Singh, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4.

Keeping in view the above and in view of the settled principle of law and since the matter is only regarding execution of the said order by the competent authority, we do not issue notice to respondent Nos.5 to 8 and dispose of the present writ petition, directing respondent No.1 to 4 to ensure that the said order is implemented at the earliest, within a period of 4 weeks from today, in accordance with law and thereafter, submit their status report to the Registrar General of this Court.
5. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
