ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Aggrieved by the registration of FIR based on a complaint made by respondent No.4, the petitioner has come up before this Court and also on the additional ground that the FIR was registered after one year and the matter is pending for last ten years.

2. The petitioner's counsel submits that he would be contended and satisfied if he is permitted to raise all his points at the time of framing of charges subject to the condition that the trial Court must refer to each and every point.

3. Considering the delay in the trial and the nature of allegations prima facie which according to the petitioner were false, the petitioner is permitted to file written synopsis at the time of framing of charges and in case the trial Court proceeds to frame the charges, the trial Court will advert to each and every point raised by the petitioner. Liberty is also reserved for the petitioner to challenge the charges in case need so arises.

4. Petition is disposed of in the terms mentioned above. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
